

# Manually Adding a "Found" Animal to Petfinder Pro

Last Updated January 25, 2022

This document provides instructions on how to add a stray animal that has been found by your organization to your existing Petfinder Pro account by leveraging the "Found" status.

#### Step 1:

Sign into your Petfinder Pro account by navigating to <a href="https://pro.petfinder.com/pro/user/login/">https://pro.petfinder.com/pro/user/login/</a>

## Step 2:

Click the "ADD A PET" button which can be found at the top of your dashboard or on your pet listings page by navigating to "Pet Listings" using the menu on the left (or hamburger menu on a Mobile view). Be sure to then select an appropriate species e.g., cat or dog to continue.

#### Step 4:

On the next page, click the drop-down under "Is [pet name]'s status not adoptable?" and change the status to "Found". You may receive a pop-up notification at the top of the page indicating that the status has been updated. The listing will not appear in searches but is still visible through a direct link. The "Found" animal will then sync via the Petfinder feed to Petco Love Lost on its next update.
